The school has a duty to send information regarding absences to the National Educational Welfare Board if your child misses more than 20 school days.

Leabhair Scoile

Ciallaíonn sé seo nach mbeidh ar thuismitheoirí/chaomhnóirí leabhair, leabhair oibre, cóipleabhair ná stáiseanóireacht riachtanach a cheannach dá bpáistí. Tá fáilte roimh an ualach airgeadais seo a bhaint de thuismitheoirí agus de chaomhnóirí, agus ó thaobh na hinbhuanaitheachta de, fanann na leabhair i seilbh na scoile agus tabharfar ar aghaidh iad nuair a úsáideadh iad mar théacsanna seachas mar leabhair oibre. É sin ráite, iarraidimid airgead ar theaghlaigh chun ealaín agus ceardaíocht, fótachóipeáil, árachas daltaí agus táillí eile.

School Books

Every primary school in Ireland receives a grant of €80 per child to cover the cost of books, workbooks, copybooks and basic stationery. This means that parents/guardians will not have to buy books, workbooks, copybooks or essential stationery for their children. The removal of some financial burden from parents and guardians is welcome and from a sustainability point of view, the books remain the property of the school and will be passed on where they have been used as texts rather than workbooks. However, we do ask for money from families to cover Arts and Crafts, Photocopying, Classroom Consumables and pupil insurance.

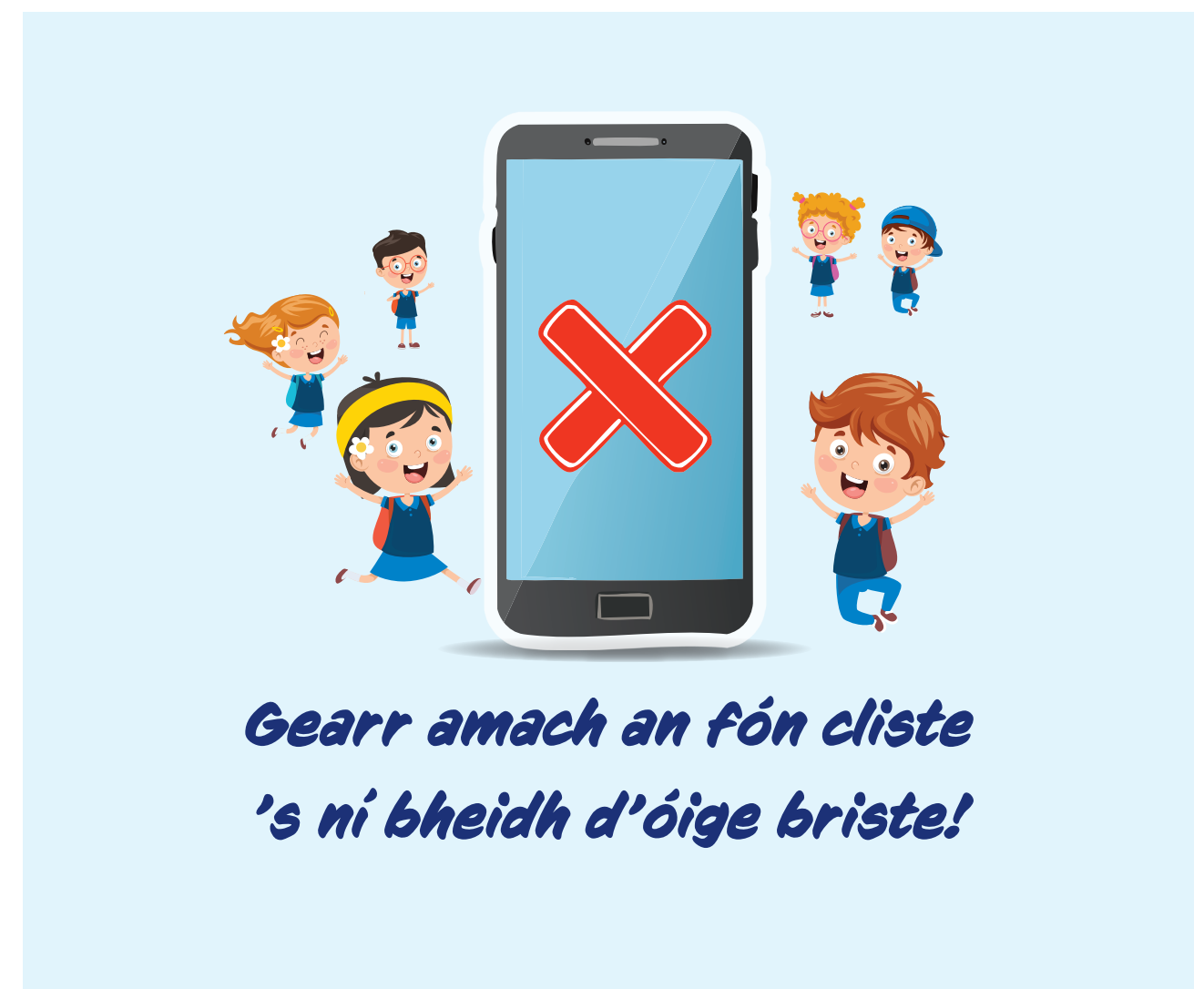

Fóin/Uaireadóirí Cliste

Cé go dtuigimid go bhféadfadh gá a bheith le fóin phóca de bharr riachtainis sláinte áirithe, ní cheadaítear do pháistí iad seo a thabhairt ar scoil ach amháin más rud é go gceapann tuismitheoir go bhfuil sé riachtanach, agus go bhfuil cead tugtha ag an bpríomhoide. Ní cheadaítear uaireadóirí cliste nó aon uirlís taifeada ar scoil. Má chasann páiste fón nó gléas eile air fad is atá siad san fhoirgneamh nó ar thailte na scoile, bainfear díobh é agus ní thabharfar ar ais é ach amháin do thuismitheoir/chaomhnóir. Ní ghlacaimid aon fhreagracht as fóin nó gléasanna cailte a thugtar ar scoil.

Phones/Smart watches

While we understand there might be a need for mobile phones for certain medical conditions, children are only permitted to bring these to school if a parent feels that it is necessary, and permission has been granted by the principal. Smart watches or any recording device are not permitted in the school. If a child switches on a phone or device while in the building or grounds it will be taken from them and returned only to a parent/guardian. We take no responsibility for lost phones or devices brought to school.



Obair Bhaile

Ba chóir go ndéanfaidh Tuismitheoir/Caomhnóir cinnte go mbíonn an obair bhaile nó iarracht chuí déanta ag na daltaí agus an leabhar nótaí sínithe ag tuismitheoir/ caomhnóir gach oíche. Cuir béim ar leith ar an léamh, na litriúcháin agus na táblaí.

- Mar rial ghinearálta faigheann gach páiste obair baile ó Luan go Déardaoin. Ní bhíonn aon obair bhaile eisithe ar an Aoine ach i gcásanna eisceachtúla nuair nach féidir leis an ngasúr an obair a dhéanamh i rith na seachtaine.
- Ba cheart go mbeadh Dialann Obair Baile ag gach páiste ó Rang 1-6 agus nótaí ón tuismitheoir cláraithe ansin. Is féidir an Obair Bhaile a chlárú ar Aladdin freisin agus tá tuismitheoirí ábalta teagmháil a dhéanamh leis an múinteoir ar Aladdin.
- Bíonn fáilte i gcónaí ó chabhair an tuismitheora/caomhnóra le obair baile sna ranganna sóisireacha ach go mba cheart go mbeadh páistí na n'árdranganna in ann an chuid id mó den obair bhaile a dhéanamh go neamhspleach. Ba cheart béim a chur ar táblaí agus litriú, agus ar an léitheoireacht ag gach aoisghrúpa agus an t-ábhar a phlé leo chun a dtuiscint a dhaingniú.
- Moltar do pháistí díriú go hiomlán ar an obair bhaile agus í idir lámha acu. Cabhraíonn suíomh oibre ciúin, compordach leo an obair a dhéanamh go héifeachtach agus go suaimhneach. Is fiú am socraithe a chur ar leataobh don obair bhaile chun dea-nósanna foghlama a chothú.
- Is féidir treoir a fháil ón múinteoir ranga maidir leis an méid ama a mholtar don obair bhaile sna ranganna éagsúla, ag brath ar aois agus ar leibhéal an pháiste.

Homework

Parents/Guardians should check that homework or a suitable effort has been made by the pupils, and the notebook signed by a parent/guardian every night. Particular emphasis should be placed on reading, spellings and tables.

- As a general rule, every child gets homework from Monday to Thursday. No homework is issued on Friday except in exceptional cases where the child was unable to do the work during the week.
- Every child from Class 1–6 should have a Homework Journal, with notes from the parent recorded there. Homework can also be recorded on Aladdin, and parents are able to contact the teacher on Aladdin.
- Help from a parent/guardian with homework is always welcome in the junior classes, but children in the senior classes should be able to do most of the homework independently. Emphasis should be placed on tables and spelling, and on reading, at every age group, and the material should be discussed with them to reinforce their understanding.
- Children are encouraged to focus fully on their homework while doing it. A quiet, comfortable workspace helps them do the work effectively and calmly. It is worth setting aside a fixed time for homework to foster good learning habits.
- Guidance can be obtained from the class teacher regarding the recommended amount of time for homework in the various classes, depending on the age and level of the child.

Lón Scoile

Beidh an scoil ag glacadh páirt sa scéim Béilte Te ó Meán Fómhair 2026 ar aghaidh. Beidh lón beag folláin ag teastáil ó na gasúir ina theannta sin. Cosc ar mhilseáin, brioscáin, guma coganta, cnónna agus deochanna coipithe.

Déanfar socruithe speisialta do pháistí a bhfuil riachtanais ar leith acu nó a bhfuil ailléirgí, íogaireachtaí nó seachaintí bia acu. Molaimid do thuismitheoirí teagmháil a dhéanamh linn roimh ré ionas gur féidir linn freastal go cuí ar riachtanais gach páiste.

School Lunch

The school will be participating in the Hot School Meals scheme from September 2026 onwards. The children will also need a small healthy lunch from home. Sweets, crisps, chewing gum, nuts and fizzy drinks are not permitted.

Special arrangements will be made for children who have particular needs or who have allergies, sensitivities or dietary restrictions. We recommend that parents contact us in advance so that we can properly cater to every child's needs.



Gníomhaíochtaí Seachchuraclaim

Tá ról fiorthábhachtach ag gníomhaíochtaí seach-churaclaim i saol ár scoile. Tugann siad deis do na daltaí a gcuid buanna agus suimeanna pearsanta a fhorbairt lasmuigh den seomra ranga, bíodh sé i gcúrsaí spóirt, ceoil, drámaíochta nó eile. Cothaíonn na gníomhaíochtaí seo muinín, comhoibriú agus scileanna sóisialta, agus neartaíonn siad spiorad pobail na scoile. Trí pháirt a ghlacadh iontu, faigheann daltaí taithí shaibhir iomlánaíoch a thacaíonn lena bhforbairt phearsanta agus acadúil araon.

Déantar gach iarracht daoine a aimsiú agus a fhostú atá inniúil ar an nGaeilge agus atá sásta í a úsáid go nádúrtha mar theanga chumarsáide na scoile. Tá sé seo thar a bheith tábhachtach chun tacú leis an bPolasaí don Oideachas Gaeltachta agus chun timpeallacht shaibhir Ghaeilge a chothú dár ndaltaí gach lá.

Extracurricular Activities

Extracurricular activities play a truly important role in the life of our school. They give pupils the opportunity to develop their personal talents and interests outside the classroom, whether in sport, music, drama or other areas. These activities foster confidence, cooperation and social skills, and strengthen the school's sense of community. By taking part in them, pupils gain a rich, well-rounded experience that supports both their personal and academic development.

Every effort is made to find and employ people who are competent in Irish and who are willing to use it naturally as the school's language of communication. This is extremely important in supporting the Policy for Gaeltacht Education and in fostering a rich Irish-language environment for our pupils every day.

Tacaíocht Foghlama inár Scoil

Is tosaíocht dúinn é go mbraitheann gach páiste fáilteach agus tacaíthe ar scoil. Tá múinteoireacht tacaíochta mar chuid dár gcur chuige chuige seo. D'fhéadfadh múinteoireacht tacaíochta a bheith i gceist le dara múinteoir ag tacú sa rang, nó múinteoir ag tógáil grúpa beag páistí, nó páiste amháin, le haghaidh tacaíochta breise lasmuigh den rang. Is féidir leis an tacaíocht seo a bheith ann ar chúiseanna acadúla, nó le haghaidh tacaíochta sóisialta, mothúchánaí nó iompraíochta. Thar a n-8 mbliana linn, gheobhaidh gach páiste roinnt tacaíochta ag leibhéal éigin

Support Teaching in Our School

It is our priority that every child should feel welcome and supported in school. Support teaching is part of how we do this. Support teaching might look like a second teacher supporting in class, or a teacher taking a small group of children, or one child, for additional support outside of class. This support can be for academic reasons, or for social, emotional or behavioural support. Over their 8 years with us, all children will receive some level of support

Ár bhFoireann Tacaíochta (SET)

I Scoil na bhForbacha, feictear réimse na tacaíochta foghlama mar rud dearfach. Cuirtear tacaíocht ar fáil í do gach dalta i bhfoirm cabhair sa seomra ranga, agus gheobhaidh formhór na bpáistí rochtain ar an am teagaisc breise seo le linn a dtréimhse anseo. Más gá, cuireann ár bhfoireann SET tacaíocht bhreise ar fáil freisin i bhfoirm aistarraingt ón rang chun teagasc grúpa bhig nó teagasc aonair a chur ar fáil. Faoi láthair tá triúr múinteoir ar ár bhfoireann SET, Niamh, Caroline agus Lucy, arna gcomhordú agus arna stiúradh ag ár bPríomhoide Tánaisteach, Niamh. Tá Deirdre ag déanamh có-mhúinteoireacht leis na naíonáin faoi láthair freisin. Déantar athbhreithniú rialta ar dháileadh na tacaíochta oideachais, agus cuirtear ar fáil í ar bhonn gearrthéarmach (bloc de 6-8 seachtaine de ghnáth) go dtí go mbraithimid go bhfuil na torthaí agus na spriocanna atá ag teastáil bainte amach. Ar an mbealach seo, beidh tacaíocht dhírithe ag páiste, grúpa nó rang ar feadh roinnt seachtainí, agus nuair a bhíonn dul chun cinn sásúil déanta, cuirtear an tacaíocht ar fáil ansin do chohórt eile páistí, grúpaí agus ranganna.

Our Special Education Teaching Team (SET)

At Scoil na bhForbacha, the area of learning support is seen as a positive. It is given to all pupils in the form of in-class support, and most children will access this extra teaching time during their time here. If required, our SET team also provide additional support in the form of withdrawal from class to allow for small group or individualised instruction. We currently have three teachers on our SET team, Niamh, Caroline and Lucy, who are coordinated and led by our Deputy Principal, Niamh. Deirdre is also currently co-teaching with the infant classes. Education support allocation is reviewed regularly and is provided on a short-term basis (usually a 6-8 week block) until we feel the desired outcomes and targets have been met. In this way a child, group or class will have targeted support for a number of weeks, and when sufficient progress has been made, the support is then provided to another cohort of children, groups and classes.



Riachtanais Bhreise agus Céard is Ceart a Dhéanamh Má Tá Imní Ort

Má tá imní ort faoi fhorbairt nó faoi oideachas do linbh, nó má cheapann tú nach bhfuil siad ag sroicheadh a gcinn siúil forbartha, molaimid duit teagmháil a dhéanamh le múinteoir ranga do linbh. I gcomhar le múinteoir oideachais speisialta (SET) do linbh, déanfaidh siad measúnú ar na tacaíochtaí atá ag teastáil do do pháiste agus, más gá, is féidir leo cabhrú leat teagmháil a dhéanamh le gairmithe ábhartha, m.sh. Teiripeoir Saothair, Teiripeoir Urlabhra agus Teanga.

Tabhair faoi deara, le do thoil, cé gur féidir linn mar mhúinteoirí tréithe áirithe a d'fhéadfadh a bheith ag do pháiste a thabhairt faoi deara, ní síceolaithe muid agus ní féidir linn do pháiste a dhiagnóisiú. Ní iarrfaimid ort an cosán seo a thógáil ach amháin má cheapaimid go bhfuil an scoil tar éis idirdhealú leordhóthanach a dhéanamh agus go bhfuil do pháiste fós ag fulaingt roinnt dúshlán.

Cuimhnigh le do thoil gurb í an luath-idirghabháil an eochair chun go n-éireoidh le do pháiste ar scoil. Bíonn sé i bhfad níos deacra ag céim níos déanaí. Iarraimid ort muid a chur ar an eolas faoi aon imní atá agat, mar go gceadaíonn sé seo dúinn ullmhú go leordhóthanach chun tacú le do pháiste, go háirithe nuair a thosaíonn siad sna Naíonáin Shóisearacha nó nuair atá siad nua inár scoil.

Má tá tuairiscí agat cheana féin ó ghairmí eile, m.sh. tuairisc leighis/shíceolaíoch, cuir in iúl dúinn é le do thoil ionas gur féidir linn bualadh leat agus tacú go maith le do pháiste agus é/í ag aistriú chuig ár scoil.

Tá páistí de gach cumas agus le riachtanais bhreise inár scoil. Creidimid go dtacaímid leis na páistí seo chomh maith agus is féidir linn agus laistigh de na hacmhainní agus na tacaíochtaí a leithdháiltear orainn ón Roinn Oideachais agus Scileanna. Creidimid go bhfuil ár n-eiticméid uilechuimsitheach agus tacúil d'gach páiste ratha a bhaint amach ag a leibhéal féin.

Additional Needs and what to do if you have concerns

If you are concerned about your child's development, education or feel they are not meeting their developmental milestones, we advise you to liaise with your child's class teacher. In conjunction with your child's SET (special education teacher) they will assess what supports are needed for your child and, if required, they can help you to get in touch with relevant professionals e.g. Occupational Therapist, Speech & Language Therapist. Please note, as teachers while we may notice certain characteristics that your child may be experiencing, we are not psychologists and cannot diagnose your child. We will only ask you to take this path if we feel that the school has differentiated adequately and that your child is still experiencing some challenges. Please remember that early intervention is the key to your child achieving success in school. It is far more difficult at a later stage. We ask that you inform us about any concerns you have as this allows us to adequately prepare to support your child, especially when they start in Junior Infants or are new to our school. If you already have reports from another professional e.g. medical/psychological report, please let us know so we can meet you and best support your child in their transition to our school. We have children of all abilities and additional needs in our school. We believe that we support these children to the best of our ability and within the resources and supports that are allocated to us from the Department of Education and Youth. We believe our ethos is inclusive and supportive of all children achieving success at individual levels.

Please see the school's Administration of Medicine's Policy and the relevant form that must be filled in by parents. These forms are also available in the school office.

Several children in our school has a severe allergic reaction to nuts and food containing nuts or seeds. It must be a joint school/home collaboration to ensure the safety of this child. This allergic reaction (anaphylactic shock) can occur through ingestion of nuts or nut products. Since this condition can be life threatening, we ask for your help in minimising the risk to this child. We would be most grateful if you would ensure that nuts or seeds are not included in your child's lunch box.

Foods containing nuts and seeds include but are not limited to:

- Raw Nuts (Cashew, Hazel Nuts, Walnuts etc)
- Nut Butters (Cashew nut butter, hazel nut butter etc.)
- Pesto (Containing Cashew Nut and Pine Nut)
- Pralines
- Tahini (Sesame seed paste)
- Cereal Bars containing nuts
- Humus (Containing Tahini)
- Bread with seeds
- Chocolate Bars (containing nuts)
- Yogurt with Nuts/seeds
- Nutella (containing Hazel Nuts)

An Bord Bainistíochta

Board of management

Our board of management (BOM) is constituted in accordance with the rules of the DES. It has eight members who are appointed for a period of four years. The BOM manages the school. The Principal is employed for the day to day running and management of the school and the Principal is responsible for teaching and learning decisions with input from teaching staff. Duties of the BOM may include changes in policies, school finance, parental involvement, challenges to teaching & learning and recruitment. If parents wish to bring any matters up with the BOM, please do so in writing to the Chairperson. However, the class teacher or the Principal should be the first port of call in most instances.

Communication procedures

We use the *Aladdin* Schools app as the primary means of communication with families. Please ensure your contact details are up to date or you may miss essential messages. Remember to let us know, if you change your mobile or landline number or email address. The school will also send a Newsletter every Friday via Aladdin noticeboard. It is essential that you keep up to date with the Newsletter for important messages, notice information on closures, dates for your diary and school news. Please communicate with your child’s teacher via their school email address. Please bear in mind that teachers will not generally check their emails until after contact time with their class so will not respond to your message immediately, they will usually respond within 24hrs. Teacher’s will vary in their communication frequency with you but all communication with come via Aladdin or school email. If you have a class related issue please make the class teacher your first port of call with an informal chat, a note or an email. Teachers are not available to take phone calls during contact hours with their class. If you feel you will need more time to talk to the teacher please make an appointment to meet them so your issue can be discussed in a discrete manner and not impact on teaching and learning time for the students. Individual parent teacher meetings will be held in October / November as per the school calendar. You will be offered a selection of days and times via the Aladdin app about one week before. These meetings are a short but a concise insight in to how your child is getting on at school. If you have an important concern, please don’t wait until then to talk to the teacher. In turn, if there are any bigger issues to discuss your class teacher will have contacted you before this date.

Íocaíochtaí Leictreonacha

There is only one link per family, ensuring you can pay all amounts due for all your children in one transaction. Once you have completed your payment, you will be issued with a reference number. You will also receive an email receipt containing transaction details and a reference number.

Home Issues

We understand that all children come from unique backgrounds and family structures. If there are issues at home such as separation, custody arrangements or family bereavement, it can be helpful to both the child and the class teacher to be aware of the situation. The issue will not be discussed with all staff unless there is a need to share it and we act with sensitivity around these situations. Parental separation or family bereavement can be challenging. Our role in the school is to support any changes, help your child develop confidence and feel secure in school and in themselves. Once we are aware of any issues then this ensures sensitivity when dealing with family issues during social personal health education (SPHE) lessons. 'My Family' is a theme that runs through the Curriculum. If there is a custody arrangement regarding your child, we need to be informed as soon as possible. Tá Coiste na Gaeilge againn i Scoil na bhForbacha, ina bhfuil beirt ionadaí ó gach rang ó Rang a hAon go Rang a Sé. Bíonn ról tábhachtach ag an gcoiste seo maidir le meas agus grá don Ghaeilge a chothú i measc na ndaltaí uile. Eagraíonn siad imeachtaí spráilúla tríd an mbliain, ina measc cluichí Gaeilge, comórtais agus tráth na gceist, chun an teanga a úsáid ar bhealach nádúrtha, taitneamhach. Bíonn baint ag an gcoiste freisin le rialacha na Gaeilge a chur chun cinn – mar shampla, spreagadh a thabhairt do dhaltai Gaeilge a labhairt sa chlós agus timpeall na scoile. Trí obair an choiste seo, cothaítear pobal beoga Gaeilge inár scoil, agus tugtar deis do na daltaí féin ceannaireacht a léiriú agus bród a bheith acu as a dteanga dhúchais.

School Committees

Currently there are two school committees at Scoil na bhForbacha. These committees are Comhairle na nÓg (Youth Council) and the Irish Language Committee. They are student-led programmes under the guidance of Scoil na bhForbacha staff.

Comhairle na nÓg is formed from students from 2nd class up to 6th class, and members are democratically elected each year during term 1. Children nominate themselves to run for Comhairle na nÓg, and they represent each class from Junior Infants to 6th Class. Comhairle na nÓg looks after the needs of the children in the school. They give a voice to every student as council members discuss class suggestions to improve the needs of the children. The Student Council tries to turn these suggestions into a reality. They represent the school at events and play a central role in school policies such as our recent 'Bí Cineálta' policy.

We have an Irish Language Committee at Scoil na bhForbacha, made up of two representatives from every class from 1st to 6th Class. This committee plays an important role in fostering respect and love for the Irish language among all pupils. They organise fun events throughout the year, including Irish-language games, competitions and quizzes, to use the language in a natural, enjoyable way. The committee is also involved in promoting the rules around Irish – for example, encouraging pupils to speak Irish in the yard and around the school. Through this committee's work, a vibrant Irish-language community is nurtured in our school, and pupils themselves are given the opportunity to show leadership and take pride in their native language.

Tugtar na torthaí do thuismitheoirí ranganna 2, 4 agus 6 sna tuairiscí scoile dheireadh na bliana. Má tá aon imní ann, déanfaimid teagmháil le thuismitheoirí.

Déanann múinteoirí ranga agus SETanna measúnú leanúnach ar na páistí i rith na bliana. Úsáidimid tástálacha atá deartha ag múinteoirí agus an measúnú caighdeánach go diagnósach lena chinntiú go bhfuil na páistí ag comhlíonadh chuspóirí an churaclaim. Ag cruinnithe tuismitheoirí-múinteoirí, úsáidfimid measúnuithe chun a insint daoibh conas atá do pháiste ag dul chun cinn. Standardised Testing

While at Scoil na bhForbacha, your child will take part in standardised testing, usually during the month of May. These tests help us to measure your child's achievement compared to the national average. The following tests will also take place:

Rang 1– ALPACA (Assessing Letter knowledge & Phonemic Awareness Class Assistant), Drumcondra Test of Numeracy

Ranganna 1-6: Drumcondra Test of Numeracy

Ranganna 2, 4 and 6 – Drumcondra Literacy (Gaeilge & English) and Drumcondra Numeracy

Results for parents of ranganna 2, 4 and 6 are given in the end-of-year school reports. If there are any concerns, we will contact parents.

Class teachers and SETs assess the children continuously throughout the year. We use teacher-designed tests as well as diagnostic standardised assessment to ensure that children are meeting the curriculum objectives. At parent-teacher meetings, we will use assessments to tell you how your child is progressing.
